Passive Voice with 被

<u>Without</u> an agent: The simplest way to form the passive is to simply add 被 before the verb. You can often translate this to "was verbed" or "was verben".

我的车被偷了。 My car was stolen. subject+被+verb

<u>With</u> an agent: The agent always comes after 被, then is followed by the verb. You can often translate this to "was verbed by agent" or "was verben by agent".

我的车被王先生偷了。 My car was stolen by mister Wang. subject+被+agent+verb

Because passive sentences that use \overleftarrow{w} are often in the completed aspect, you will usually see 2 (if negative) , $\overleftarrow{\eta}$, and/or $\overrightarrow{1}$ somewhere nearby, but not always.

他被对手击倒。 He was knocked down by his opponent.

或者把老虎打死,或者被老虎吃掉,二者必居其一。 Either kill the tiger, or be killed by him, one way or the other.

Lit. "He a moment ago by a 100% stranger hugged a bit. He also/still self be called some 'Magua', heaven knows this is what meaning.
